REMARKS

Connectors shall be 45 degrees and identical to those specified by MBARI for the MARS Experiment. Both connectors shall be terminated to a single 64 meter length of Falmat Underwater Cable that will be supplied by MBARI. The cable specs are included as an attachment. The internal wires in the cable shall be secured to each connector as per the attached MBARI FOCE Cable Pinout. Upon completion of successful connector testing, the cable shall be completely severed at 1/2 the total length. This will result in two separate connectors, each having a molded cable length of 32 meters.
