Where can I park?

Maker Parking:

Setup Days - On the Thursday, parking is free.

Friday, Saturday & Sunday - A parking pass is required. Makers can purchase discounted parking for \$20.00 per vehicle for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Discount parking passes can only be purchased at the Maker Service Center on Thursday, May 14th from 10am - 6pm and are not available for purchase on show days.

Free Parking:

Saturday & Sunday, there will be plenty of Free Parking available offsite. (Detailed Info: makerfaire.com) Please plan for a short walk or shuttle ride from some of these lots. On Thursday, there is free parking at the Fairgrounds for setup.

Is public transportation available?

Will you have bike parking?

Yes, secure Valet Bicycle Parking is provided on Saturday and Sunday.

Will there be ATM machines on-site?

Yes, ATM machines will be on-site. To avoid waiting in line, it is best to bring cash for entrance fees and food.
