Begin notice:

The Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute (MBARI) will be conducting 24/7 autonomous, unmanned maritime vehicle operations of a Liquid Robotics, Inc. Waveglider (www.liquidr.com), **from 27 JUN 2016 through 19 AUG 2016**. We plan to deploy a vehicle in the vicinity of Moss Landing that will operate continuously between latitudes 35 07.237N degrees and 36 41.46N degrees and will extend shoreward from as far West as 122 58.59W degrees longitude. Operations consist of scientific ocean data collection. Wave Glider carries no fuel, lubricants, or hydrocarbons, is wave powered, remotely attended from MBARI, moving at speeds of ~1kt, and designed to give way or part if encountered by a vessel. It is approximately 6.5' x 2' (surfboard size), yellow in color, with a contact plaque and mast extending 1 meter above the water surface supporting a flag. Mariners are advised to use caution when transiting the area.
