REMARKS

Cable assemblies as per MBARI Drawing 100221160-05-B "LRAUV ANTENNA WET COAX CABLE FABRICATION". NOTE: Raw cable stock is customer supplied material. Because the core material was supplied in several discrete lengths that were mechanically joined before over-molding, several electrical discontinuities exist in the over-molded cable. Discrete lengths should be checked for electrical continuity and/or jacket anomalies before connectorization and defective lengths discarded.
