(SWSI), Environment Canada and the Canadian Meteorological Centre in Dorval, PQ., through a Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) with Environment Canada.

JouBeh is responsible for the activation and provisioning of GTS services. SWSI is responsible for the formatting, quality assurance and quality control of environmental data and the posting of the data in a rapid manner.

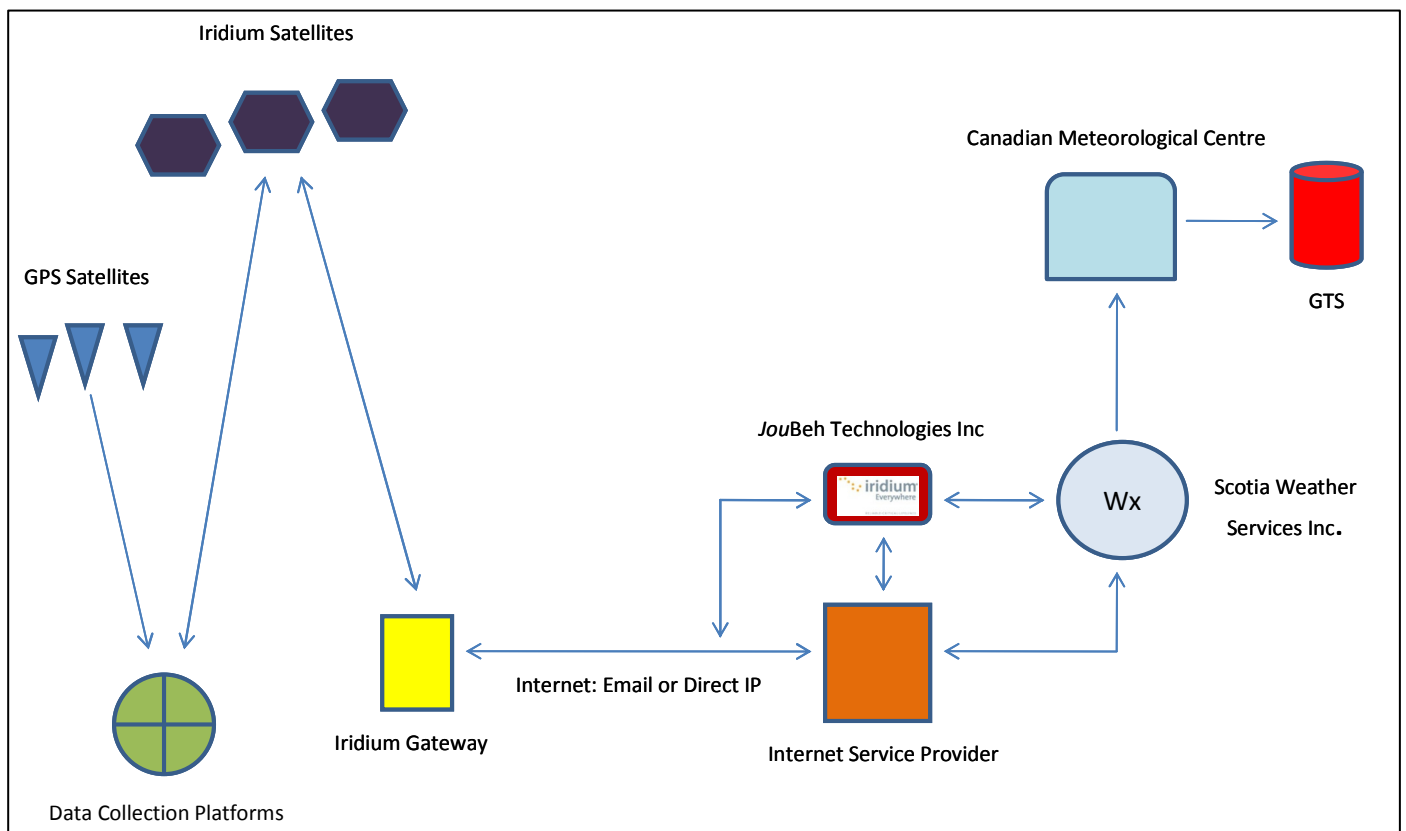


Figure (1) - A schematic of the data flow from left to right of data collection platform to the GTS

1. Provide valid WMO numbers
2. Provide an approximate time and location position of deployment
3. Recycle unused or inactive WMO numbers
