



936 UNIVERSAL LINE REEL

The 936 Universal Line Reel is constructed so that it fits all configurations of gun barrels.

For Wooden Guns: The slots allow it to be affixed with wood screws.

For Metal Guns: Two hose clamps must be purchased separately (any hardware or auto parts store) which assemble around the barrel and through the slots. If you are assembling it to a JBL gun with the black plastic Tru-Glide on top, you must cut two places for the clamps to fit. This can be done with a hacksaw blade or a serrated knife blade.

The 937 and 938 Line Reels are made to quickly assemble to any round barrel.

Assembly for JBL Line Reels is as follows:

1. Clean assembly area thoroughly with rubbing alcohol and a Kleenex or paper towel. Do not use other cleaners as they leave a film and the contact tape will not hold properly.
2. Assemble the line reel in place and tighten the screws. Do not remove the green protective film or you will not be able to slide the reel on the barrel for perfect alignment.
3. When you are satisfied with the position of your reel, take a sharp pencil and draw the outline of the clamp where it makes contact with the barrel. (This is so you can return it to the exact same spot.) Remove clamping screws, remove green film, and replace reel on barrel (carefully repositioning it inside pencil marks).
4. Replace clamp and tighten screws. Press both sides of clamps firmly to barrel. For best results, allow 24 hours to set.
